Your memorandum to the Haines Borough Assembly is well written, factual and informed.

Hopefully my comments to FERC will be completed before your meeting. Until we complete our filing with FERC, I am unable to state anything for the record on the departmental position. You will be copied on my filing (the same day).

One thing which concerns me is that your information to the assembly only lists the APT-GLH statements filed in the request for use of the TLP. Clearly the agencies at the meeting in Juneau disputed the statements of APT-

GLH on resource issues, available information and study effort and reporting. Most of the six points were disputed by the agencies in Juneau. My concern is that the assembly might view the points presented by APT-GLH as truth, since there is little or no dispute mentioned until the end of your memorandum.

Thanks for the opportunity to review your memorandum and to provide process information as requested.
