To Borough Assembly members, Mayor Hill and Borough Manager Seward,

I am not in support of RESOLUTION No. 16-06-68 for the following reasons:

Borough code 5.18.080(I) states: if the assembly passes a resolution to form a heliski map committee, the manager convenes a committee by June 10 and the committee gives its recommendations to the manager by July 15.

- consideration of this resolution at this time would not comply with Borough code 5.18.080(I)

- it would establish a precedent that would contradict all future Borough code related to issues and send the wrong signal to our new Borough Manager as he begins his tenure here in Haines.

- the terms of RESOLUTION No. 16-06-68 are troubling in light of the years of work that have gone into establishing a heliski industry in Haines, it rushes, in my opinion, a process that requires thoughtful consideration with plenty of time for public participation.
