

WHY IS THE TONGASS DOING A FIVE-YEAR REVIEW NOW?

When the Forest Service formally adopted the current Forest Plan in 2008, the agency committed to doing a review of the plan's effectiveness in five years. Now, in 2013, the Tongass Forest Supervisor is looking to gain greater insight into the Forest Plan and its implementation over the last five years and to determine whether any actions at this time are needed to clarify or adjust the plan.

WHAT HAPPENS TO THE COMMENTS?

The Forest Supervisor will consider all feedback and determine the need for a response to each issue. Examples of responses may include written clarification of sections of the Forest Plan, or a more formal plan supplement, revision, or amendment. The Forest Supervisor will share the responses with the public by early 2014, at the conclusion of the five-year review process. The final report will be available at the Tongass National Forest website.


ARE THERE OTHER PARTS TO THE FIVE-YEAR REVIEW?

Yes. The five-year review process will also include preparing a five-year monitoring and evaluation report, completion of an information needs assessment, and review of the Forest Plan's conservation strategy. 

TONGASS NATIONAL FOREST LAND & RESOURCE MANAGEMENT PLAN FIVE-YEAR REVIEW



The Tongass National Forest is looking for feedback on its main guiding document, the Tongass National Forest Land & Resource Management Plan (Forest Plan), on the heels of the plan's five year anniversary. We are looking for stakeholder and general public comments on the plan. In addition, the Tongass will lead a review of the Forest Plan's "conservation strategy," the system of old growth reserves and management standards that protects fish and wildlife across the forest. A 5-year monitoring & evaluation report & an information needs assessment will also occur.

The Tongass National Forest provides a broad range of benefits to society from the Forest, from recreation opportunities to salmon to wood products. In order to ensure that today's activities on the forest do not impact these benefits over the long run, managers follow the guidance of the Forest Plan, most recently approved in 2008. Now, the Forest is looking for feedback from the public on whether the plan is working as promised, or whether some changes are needed.

The Tongass National Forest wants to hear from a wide range of people about how well the Forest Plan has been working over the last five years. The public comment period will be open between January and June, 2013.
