Good afternoon, Bill: I have received several emails and calls from a resident there and after discussing the options previously discussed at the last meeting, she (Kate Palmer) indicated that she and her husband had gone out to the site and took a series of measurements from the edge of pavement toward the cliff side, and found that there were numerous spots in which they could clear brush and create small parking areas that were at least 8 feet from the edge of pavement. DOT is in agreement that this is a manageable solution at this time and would alleviate the immediate roadside safety issue if the parking areas are selected and developed properly. Should the residents choose to proceed in this manner, I will issue a Special Use Permit for the work within the right of way and our maintenance staff person Matt Boron will provide oversight to ensure proper siting and grading of the areas.

I think it is safe to cancel the meeting at this time and pursue the process as described above. Thanks!
