What is the Future of Energy?

The Energy discussions will begin with a Haines Chamber of Commerce sponsored lunch at noon on June 26th at the Haines Borough Public Library. Mayor Stephanie Scott will give an overview of the afternoon Roundtable, and Alaska Energy Authority Deputy Director Gene Therriault will give the keynote speech.

The Alaska Energy Authority (AEA) is tasked with charting a path for affordable energy for communities that will not have ready access to the proposed Alaska natural gas pipeline. Mr. Therriault will talk about Alaska's energy issues in general and how regions across the state are being reached out to – and how Haines, Skagway and Southeast as a region fit into the scheme of things.

Following the Chamber luncheon, an “Energy Roundtable” will be convened, featuring local energy developers and providers: Bob Grimm, Alaska Power Company; Jodi Mitchell, IPEC; and John Floreske, Southern Energy; along with Gene Therriault, Alaska Energy Authority. They will address the Borough Assembly, Planning Commissioners and invited guests from Skagway.

The Roundtable will be co-facilitated by Mayor Scott and Robert Venables, Southeast Conference Energy Coordinator.
