

POSITION OPENING

Firefighter/Training Officer



The Haines Borough is accepting applications for a full-time, year-round Firefighter/Training Officer. This position carries out duties under the immediate supervision of the Fire Chief and includes authority to act under AS 18.70. The Firefighter/Training Officer is responsible for all Haines Volunteer Fire Department training activities; maintaining facilities, hydrants, automotive equipment, portable equipment and tools of the department; and supervision and evaluations of any paid staff.

Minimum Qualifications: High school graduate or equivalent; be certified or certifiable within 2 years as an EMT 3; response time from primary residence should be within 10 minutes for callout purposes; good physical health required; and must be capable, willing and experienced in interior fire suppression and attack. Alaska CDL class B driver's license, Firefighter 2 certification, and minimum level 2 fire extinguisher state certification required (or completed within reasonable timeframe agreed to by the Fire Chief).

Wage & Benefits: \$20.10 to \$21.10 per hour. This is a union position subject to union dues and includes medical benefits, PERS retirement, personal leave, and paid holidays.

Application Deadline: Open until filled.
