The following special conditions will apply:

- Cut only dead or downed timber.
- All portions suitable for firewood, of any tree standing or down which is cut for firewood, will be completely removed. No waste will be tolerated.
- All stumps resulting from firewood cutting will not exceed a height of twelve (12) inches above the ground.
- All wood cutting will be carried on in a manner that will not interfere with other authorized operations.
- Extreme caution will be taken at all times to prevent the obstruction or littering of any public road or highway, any private road, or other main road providing access to borough land during or as a result of any operations necessary for the removal of firewood.
