I'm writing you because I strongly oppose the request for a conditional use permit for a Dog Kennel on lot 33, Tanani Bay Subdivision. The request for this conditional use permit was requested by Mr. Jonathan Richardson. My wife and I reside at 1150 Lutak Road on Tanani Bay. I personally have never met Mr. Richardson but I know and have seen his pack of four dogs running at large with no supervision in the area on several occasions in the past  
I know of two occasions when Mr. Richardson's pack of dogs has threatened pedestrians walking along Lutak Road in the area of Dolphin Street. Mr. Richardson has been contacted by the Haines Police Department (Officer Adam Patterson) on more than one occasion and by at least one resident concerning his dogs running loose to no avail. Because of the threat Mr. Richardson's dog pack poses to pedestrians and other dogs, my wife will no longer walk from our residence toward the Ferry Terminal, but chooses to walk towards town and away from the potential threat that this pack of dogs has instilled in the neighborhood. Because I do not personally know Mr. Richardson, I can not attest to his professionalism as a businessman, but I have a great concern if this conditional use permit is approved because of the way Mr. Richardson has allowed his personal dogs to freely run at large in the past.
