Subject: Harbor Trash and Waste Disposal Fees

1. I have attached a number of communities Ports and Harbor approaches to Trash and Waste Disposal. I propose that we make a change to Borough Code 16 to reflect that if a vessel owner is working on his vessel and creating construction waste that he takes that waste directly to the landfill himself and does not dispose of it in the Harbor dumpster. In addition, I believe it is time to consider putting a fee on disposal of oil for non-harbor customers. I believe we should start charging \$1.00 per gallon for non-harbor customers. For ethylene glycol disposal we should also charge \$1.00 per gallon for all customers as this cost us a lot of money (\$250 per 55 gallon drum) to get rid of.

2. Propose code reading:

16.28.010 Prohibited acts.

It shall be unlawful for any person using the borough port and harbor facilities to commit any of the following prohibited acts:

D. To throw or otherwise cause to be deposited gasoline, oil, trash, garbage or refuse on any float or into the water of the borough port and harbor facilities. To use the borough port and harbor refuse containers for non-harbor or non-port use. **It is prohibited to leave snow removed from vessels on any dock, float, or finger. To create construction or project waste and dispose of it in the harbor refuse containers. Vessel construction or project waste shall be taken by the owner or contractor directly to the landfill.**

3. The fee changes would just be proposed and reflected on the borough fee sheet.

18. Garbage, waste oil disposal fees and water fees.

a. Vessels not using the harbor facilities for moorage but disposing of garbage or waste oil or obtaining water shall be charged fees as follows:

i. Garbage disposal, \$20.00 per cubic yard;

ii. Waste oil disposal, \$4.00 per five gallons, \$35.00 per barrel;

iii. Potable water, \$15.00 minimum or \$0.03 per gallon, whichever is greater.

(b) Solid Waste Fees. In addition to all other fees and charges, all boat owners or operators who are subject to moorage fees under KMC 14.40.020 or 14.40.030 shall pay an additional solid waste fee as follows:

(1) Daily Moorage. Boat owners or operators subject to the daily moorage facilities use fee under KMC 14.40.030(a) shall pay an additional \$0.06 per foot LOA per day.

(2) Monthly, Quarterly, Semi-Annual Moorage. Boat owners who have been granted reserved moorage under KMC 14.40.020 shall pay an additional \$0.16 per month per foot of overall boat length or stall length, whichever is greater; subject to a minimum fee equal to the charge applied to a 20-foot boat. Boat owners or operators who pay moorage facilities use fees on a 30- or 90-day basis under KMC 14.40.030(b) or (c) shall pay an additional \$0.16 per foot per month, subject to a minimum fee equal to the charge applied to a 20-foot boat regardless of the overall boat length.

(3) All solid waste fees shall be due and paid at the time that mooring facilities reserved moorage fees or open moorage facilities use fees are due. Solid waste fees are nonrefundable; provided, however, that upon cancellation of a reserved mooring pursuant to KMC 14.40.020(f) the solid waste fee shall be rebated on the same basis as the reserved moorage fee. The solid waste fee shall be considered a reserved moorage, open moorage, and service fee under KMC 14.40.060 and Chapter 14.50 KMC and all provisions of said sections, including those for late payment charges, liens, impoundment, and loss of reserved moorage, also apply to unpaid or late solid waste fees. The solid waste fee shall be due and paid in full regardless of any interruption, inadequacy, unavailability or loss of solid waste services.

(c) Additional Solid Waste and Water Fee for Live Aboard Boats. In addition to the fees due under subsection (b) of this section and in addition to all other fees and charges, boat owners or operators of live aboard boats shall pay an additional solid waste and water fee of \$32.50 per month regardless of the size of the boat. The additional solid waste and water fee shall not be refundable or rebated except under the following circumstances:

(1) A boat owner who cancels a reserved moorage in the manner set forth in KMC 14.40.020(f) shall receive a partial rebate based upon the number of full months remaining in their current billing period;
or

(2) A boat owner who has a reserved moorage space under KMC 14.40.020 shall receive a refund for each period in which the boat is continuously absent from the boat harbors for a period of one month or more; provided, however, that the owner has notified the harbormaster in advance of each such absence and applies for a refund within two days of the boat's return to a boat harbor. Notification and application for refund must be in writing on forms approved by the harbormaster. Refunds shall be based upon the number of full months. No refunds shall be made for absences of less than one month.

All additional solid waste and water fees shall be due and paid at the time that mooring facilities reservation fees or open moorage facilities use fees are due. The additional solid waste and water fee shall be considered reserved moorage, open moorage, and service fee under KMC 14.40.060 and 14.50.020 and all provisions of said sections including those for late payment charges, liens, impoundment and loss of reserved moorage apply equally to unpaid or late additional solid waste and water fees. The additional solid waste and water fee shall be due and paid in full regardless of any interruptions, inadequacy, unavailability or loss of solid waste or water services.

Sitka

13.10.200 Garbage facilities.

Objects too large to fit into the litter container shall be disposed of at the municipal landfill by the owner at his/her expense. (Ord. 14-07 § 4 (part), 2014.)

Wrangell

Allows only standard garbage any construction or project garbage must be taken to the landfill by the vessel owner.
