

Sign would be made of plywood sign board panels backed by 2x4 wood framing so that each panel dismantles with framing attached, thus diminishing the potential for facade damage in moving and dismantling. Substructure would be bolted together from behind and attached to dock with appropriate supports. There would be four panels - two 4x8 panels with a 2x4' panel in the middle bottom and one 2x4' panel on the top center. Paint can either be enamel house paint or boat paint. The original sign was enamel house paint and withstood numerous winters without appreciable wear. Since this sign would be removed in winter, it will last even longer. Price of 5000 would include cost of materials - plywood, paint and backing 2x4's, but does not include installation on the dock itself. Ideally this would be done by Borough crews. Please see drawing for sign image concept. Colors would be more intense in final production. Lettering would be improved in final production as well. Business licenses are on file with Borough and State.
