### If you are sick...

**Call the SEARHC Haines Health Center at 766-6300** if you are experiencing Covid-19 symptoms, even if mild. SEARHC is testing all symptomatic patients, regardless of ability to pay. Additional testing resources are available in Juneau, including asymptomatic testing.

**Symptoms can include** – fever, aching, cough and shortness of breath, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell.

## Travelers to Haines

Within Alaska: permitted for all purposes  
From Outside: testing or quarantine required, [Plans of Protection](#) still required for critical infrastructure workers  
Canada Border: restricted to essential travel until at least June 21

## Cruise Ships

Canadian ban on large cruise ships until at least Oct. 31  
Small cruise ships to Haines under discussion.
