DATA and CURRENT SITUATION:

What is the outcome we are hoping to achieve with our solid waste plan?

(if time) DISCUSS POSSIBLE SECTIONS FOR DEVELOPING A SOLID WASTE PLAN:

These are the over-arching topics that came up last meeting. We should discuss which ones take precedence and begin research and tackling them section by section at our meetings.

What is the mission or purpose of a solid waste plan?

- Borough involvement How do we address the relationship between private enterprise, nonprofits and the borough in solid waste management? What relationships would we like to see changed or different?
- Recycling and waste reduction: We all agree recycling and waste reduction incentives should be included in a plan how this is integrated is yet to be determined. Are there other waste reduction ideas we want to see implemented?
- Basic Management mandatory vs voluntary, self-haul and up the highway services, how to pay for it, how to implement it.
- Contingency Does the borough have n contingency in place for managing solid waste if the current service is interrupted? If not, this committee can recommend such a plan be developed by the borough in conjunction with our work on a solid waste management plan.
