BOARD DECISION:

**Motion #1:** Michael Fullerton moved to "recommend to the Borough Assembly to make it a priority to fight for the return of the AST Blue shirt", the motion carried unanimously.

**Motion #2:** Jim Stanford moved to recommend option 3- "Change the current Borough wide Medical service area to an Emergency service area covering emergency police response, ambulance and search and rescue. This may require a Borough wide vote and could be funded by an increase in the current sales tax being used to fund the Medical Service area and/or a portion of the property taxes already collected from the people in the outer Borough. This would not include fire protection as that is already covered by separate service areas." The motion carried unanimously.


RATIONALE:

On April 26, 2017, the Borough Assembly passed the following motion:

**Motion: FRIEDENAUER** moved to "refer the question of police response outside the townsite to the Public Safety Commission for a recommendation," and the motion carried unanimously.

After Discussion, the Public Safety Commission recommended the above actions in the presented order. Their preference was to fight for the return of an AST Blue shirt, but, if not possible, to expand the existing Medical Service area to include Emergency Services (police, ambulance and search and rescue).
