I support the intent of the ordinance but I would like to suggest a couple changes because the draft text is not very specific in regards to defining the size of the storage facilities. As stated it appears any sized aqueous storage facility, such as septic systems, would become illegal.

A suggested change:

It is unlawful for any person, association, corporation, or other entity to **build** _____ **and/or operate an** aqueous storage facility **greater than 5000 gallons in capacity** which handles hazardous materials, waste, or substances within one mile of any surface body of water.
