

A Resolution of the Haines Borough Assembly authorizing the Borough Manager to purchase a 1,000 gallon aboveground fuel storage tank from Anchorage Tank for the approximate amount of \$35,000 plus shipping.

WHEREAS, Delta Western has shut down its large equipment fueling operation so that Public Works now needs to use the gas station to fill its large equipment; and

WHEREAS, the above change has required approximately two hours a day of staff time to fuel equipment, when needed; and

WHEREAS, it is costly in terms of both staff time and inconvenience to the public (tying up a gas pump for two hours) to continue to fill equipment at the gas station; and

WHEREAS, the new system proposed will reduce staff time to approximately 45 minutes time to refill, at our public works facility; and

WHEREAS, during snow plowing season, large equipment is fueled daily; and

WHEREAS, the equipment sinking fund has sufficient funds for the purchase of the fuel storage tank; and

WHEREAS, staff has obtained a quote from Anchorage Tank for \$33,325 for a 1000 gallon above ground fuel storage tank; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Haines Borough Assembly authorizes the Borough Manager to purchase a 1,000 gallon aboveground fuel storage tank from Anchorage Tank for \$35,000 plus shipping.
