My Name is Cindy Buxton. I am a longtime resident of Haines. I am very much opposed to the use of the Lutak Dock for shipping of ore. I am opposed to the planning of such a dock or seeking of funding for such a dock.

Our local economy is strengthened by the retirees and the families that support themselves by telecommuting within a wide variety of business sectors. Retired folks spend their money in town, which makes jobs for other people, and do a tremendous amount of volunteer work for the community, which makes our town a much better place to live. Tele-commuters bring their jobs to town with them. **These groups of people moved here because of the quality of life**. They did not choose Skagway, which is an example of a town that has industrial scale tourism and ore trucks, and which does not have the same year-round vibrant community or economy that Haines has.

If ore trucks starting running down the highway and through town on an hourly basis, the quality of life will be severely diminished.
