This is a resolution to obligate us to pay hundreds of thousands of dollars for a company to design an ore terminal before the need or desire by the community has been determined.

Tonight each of you, theoretically, will reflect what the community wants. The burning question is, "What does the community want?"

The answer: you don't really know, because you haven't asked.

Your obligation to this community is to conduct open public meetings to provide detailed information and answer community concerns. Because that has not happened, you need to take no action on resolution 22-09-996.

lack of stakeholder involvement and support for the MARAD grant
