

I moved here in 1966 there was 2 sawmills running 15 to 20 trucks making 3 to 4 trips a day hauling lumber and logs to the city dock which at that time was almost twice the size it is now. They were shipping millions feet of export logs and timber. The Schnabel mill was under construction and was running in 1968. Lutak Dock and Schnabel mill has been heavy industrial area.

This is the best place for heavy industrial waterfront area there is nobody living on either side of it for about 2 miles. Southeast Road builder property is between these areas.

This area is the last good piece of industrial property that is here in Haines. It has federal funded state highway running thru it. I see no reason not to uphold this permit.
