Since the beginning of the process to rebuild the Lutak Dock, many in the community have asked for transparency and a chance for meaningful dialogue. So far that hasn't happened.

Now, that the mismanagement of the Porcupine Road work may end up costing us \$1.4 million, it is imperative that everything be done correctly on the dock project and that we are absolutely clear on how much it will cost to build and to maintain.

I think that no one in Haines is opposed to a new dock that meets our needs, but what many of us are opposed to is a dock that meets the needs of industries, such as ore mines. Such industries should pay for their own infrastructure. We are told that the current dock plan wouldn't work for ore transport, but the evidence doesn't wholeheartedly support that claim.

We apparently have until September 2024 to finalize plans for the dock. I ask that the assembly take this time now to allow all of the contradictory information to be researched in full and to make sure that the dock that is built is exactly what we need.
