The commerce committee reviews and recommends legislative and policy matters pertaining to ports and harbors, tourism, economic strategies, land and resource, and planning and zoning. This committee maintains a working relationship with empowered and advisory boards, the Haines Chamber of Commerce and the Haines Economic Development Corporation.

Discussion/Business Conducted

- 3. Discussion/Action topics:

Severance Taxes on extractive resources. Discussion re: selectivity or targeting of resources as unfair. All extractive resources should be taxed because principle is same: once removed, the benefit of the resource is gone. "Renewable" vs. "nonrenewable" is also an arguable standard, as the resource is not renewable within a human lifetime. Decision: advance a tax ordinance that taxes timber, fish, gravel, rock and ore. Decision: Tax only on resources that are exported from Borough. Outstanding issues: taxation of Borough-owned resources? Marine products: how to establish jurisdiction with mobile fleet/processors. Allowable to tax resources taken from State lands in competitive sale? Chair will prepare a draft ordinance for discussion at February meeting.
