Please do not changes meeting times, (Assembly or Planning Commission), or extend the permit review time period.

I find it concerning that after many years of current code dates for meetings, and time requirements for permits to be reviewed that we suddenly need a change for what appears to be staff issues.

Over the last few years the Borough administration has often answered questions asked by the Assembly with versions of: "we have not gotten to that yet."

Many items for agenda have been delayed due to the Manager not having completed required research, including agenda times that code required to be on current agendas.

Codifying an additional 20 day delay for permit issuance is adding unnecessary delay burdens on the citizens who are already challenged with short construction seasons.

This is not a code or time issue, this is a current staffing issue. Please do not punish the citizens for the future to try and solve a temporary staff issue.
