Please insure that every penny of legal expense incurred by the Borough to defend the Planning Commissions decision to deny a conditional use permit for a heliport to Big Salmon Ventures is repaid by the company. This was their third attempt to force this permit in this neighborhood, which has caused considerable expense to the Borough that goes far beyond the current bill.

Regarding the next Borough manager hire I believe at this time that it would be best to hire an interim manager that has education and experience with municipal administration and oversight. Someone local that knows what the job entails.
