HAINES BOROUGH, ALASKA ORDINANCE No. 12-01-279

Adopted

An Ordinance of the Haines Borough Assembly amending Haines Borough Code Section 5.18.080(f)(4) establishing global positioning data monitoring.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE HAINES BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:

Section 1. <u>Classification</u>. Section 4 of this ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and the adopted amendment shall become a part of the Haines Borough Code.

Section 2. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance is effective upon adoption.

Section 4. <u>Amendment of Section 5.18.080(F)(4)</u>. Section 5.18.080(F)(4) of the Haines Borough Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.18.080 Commercial ski tours, commercial ski productions and special ski competition events.

F. General Permit Conditions and Regulations.

4. Every commercial ski tour operator shall use global positioning system ("GPS") equipment capable of tracking and preserving information establishing the route taken by the helicopter to and from the skiing and snowboarding area and all landings. This information shall be <u>cataloged in a manner requested by the borough and</u> provided to the borough on a bi-weekly basis <u>when requested by the borough</u> during each commercial ski tour season. <u>Borough requests for this information are limited to enforcement of borough-permitted activity.</u>
