Emphasize Compliance not Enforcement



Emphasize Compliance not Enforcement

- Discretion by law enforcement personnel



Emphasize Compliance not Enforcement

- Discretion by law enforcement personnel
- Authorizes warnings instead of citations for first offenses.

- Key to providing transparency and oversight of enforcement.



Maintain Record of all Fines
