RESOLUTION No. 16-05-675

**Adopted**

**A Resolution of the Haines Borough Assembly authorizing the extension and increased size of 450-feet of water main along Bear Trails Lane at a borough cost of approximately \$28,000.**

**WHEREAS**, a developer proposed to extend the water main to two lots along Bear Trails Lane at an estimated cost of \$15,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the Haines Borough would like to increase the size of the service to accommodate the goals of the Haines Borough's Water and Sewer Master Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Haines Borough has applied to ADEC for funding to extend the Bear Trails Lane water main on multiple occasions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Small Tracts Water Main extension project, of which this is a component, is ranked #13 on the statewide Alaska Drinking Water Funding Priority Planning List; and

**WHEREAS**, Haines Borough Code 18.60.010 states "...The borough may require any or all parts of such installation to be oversized, however the additional cost beyond the size needed for the development will be borne by the borough"; and

**WHEREAS**, the Haines Borough will provide the approximate \$28,000 to increase the main to 8" HDPE, add a three valve cluster, add a fire hydrant, and an additional service; and

**WHEREAS**, the developer will provide the \$15,000 it would have cost to provide the smaller 2" service to his two lots; and

**WHEREAS**, the Haines Borough has appropriate CIP funds for design and extension of water utilities,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Haines Borough Assembly authorizes the extension and increased size of 450-feet of water main along Bear Trails Lane.
