Dear Mayor Hill, Assembly Members and Manager Seward,

Thank you for your letter dated September 16, 2016. I request that the Haines Borough Assembly put the issue of the violation of my Constitutional Rights on the agenda at the next meeting of the Assembly. You are welcome to listen to all the recordings I have.

The police officers, Josh Dryden and officer brown that ".....provided the order" on June 29, 2016, that I was not to trespass in the Haines Borough Administration Building, did not state a time limit for the no trespass order. I have a recording of what the officers said to me on June 29, 2016.

Your letter dated September 16, 2016, is the only document I have received from the Borough regarding the verbal order not to trespass, issued to me by the officers on June 29, 2016. I did not receive the "Officer's report (enclosed)" as stated in your letter of September 16, 2016. Please provide me a copy of that report.

My request to address the Assembly is to ask for:

1. Public apology for violation of My Constitutional Rights.
2. Public retraction of misstatements made by the Haines Borough.
3. Payment of my Legal fees incurred.
4. Educate police officers and borough employees on the Constitutionally protected rights of the people.
