

A Resolution of the Haines Borough Assembly summarizing the disbursement of CARES Act funds in the Haines Borough

WHEREAS, The Haines Borough received federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Funds (hereinafter CARES Act Funds) totalling \$4,007,216.22 for necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) passed through the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development; and

WHEREAS, The Haines Borough previously adopted Resolution 20-06-872 to identify disbursement from the first tranche of CARES ACT Funds received; and

WHEREAS, The Haines Borough also adopted Resolution 20-09-884 to further dedicate CARES Act Funds to other needs; and

WHEREAS, The Assembly Ad Hoc CARES Act Committee has made recommendations adopted by the Haines Borough Assembly for the disposition of the additional CARES Act Funds; and

WHEREAS, The Haines Borough desires to summarize the CARES Act Funds disbursements to date:
