

A Resolution of the Haines Borough Assembly adopting the Haines Borough 2022 Hazard Mitigation Plan Update.

WHEREAS, hazard mitigation is any sustained action taken to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property from natural hazards and their effects; and

WHEREAS, a multi-hazard mitigation plan identifies and coordinates risk mitigation efforts with state, federal and local partners; and

WHEREAS, a current and approved Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is required for the funding of Haines Borough Emergency and Mitigation funds through the State of Alaska or Federal Emergency Management Association (FEMA); and

WHEREAS, local plans must be formally updated and approved by FEMA every five years; and


WHEREAS, Borough staff drafted the 2022 Haines Borough Hazard Mitigation Plan (plan) in collaboration with the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management (DHS & EM); and

WHEREAS, FEMA has reviewed the plan and has committed to approval of the plan after Assembly adoption,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Haines Borough Assembly hereby adopts the 2022 Haines Borough Hazard Mitigation Plan Update.
