Adopted

An Ordinance of the Haines Borough amending various provisions of the Haines Borough Code to designate certain violations of Borough law as minor offenses and to establish a fine schedule for certain offenses and to provide for other penalties for violations.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE HAINES BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:

- **Section 1.** <u>Classification</u>. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and the adopted amendment shall become a part of the Haines Borough Code.
- **Section 2.** <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.
- **Section 3.** <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall become effective thirty days following adoption.
- **Section 4.** Amendment of Chapter 1.24.040. Chapter 1.24.040 of the Haines Borough Code of Ordinances is clarified to read as follows:

Section 5. Amendment of Section 5.01.070. Section 5.01.070 of the Haines Borough Code is hereby amended as follows:

5.01.070 Penalties.

Operation of any business enterprise for which a permit **or license** is required under this title without **such** a permit **or license**, or the failure to follow any permit condition, or the unlawful securing of a permit, shall constitute a minor offense punishable by a fine of \$500-250.00 for each offense, unless a different amount is specified in HBC 1.24.040, plus any surcharge required to be imposed by AS 12.55.039. All penalties described in Chapter 1.24 HBC shall be applicable to this title.

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Section 6. Amendment of Section 8.18.080(A). Section 8.18.080(A) of the Haines Borough Code is hereby amended, as follows:

8.18.080 Violations and penalties.

It is unlawful for any person to smoke in any area where smoking is prohibited or for any person who owns, manages, operates, or otherwise controls the use of premises subject to this chapter to fail to comply with the provisions of this chapter or to discharge, refuse to hire, or in any other manner retaliate or discriminate against any employee, applicant for employment, or customer because such employee, applicant for employment or customer insists upon compliance with a requirement of this chapter.

- A. A person who smokes in an area where smoking is prohibited by the provisions of this chapter is subject to a fine of \$50.00 \$250.00.
- B. A person, owner, manager, employer, or operator who controls the use of premises subject to this chapter and violates any provision of this chapter is subject to a penalty in the amount of \$200.00 for every violation of this chapter.

An employee who works in a setting where an employer allows smoking does not waive or otherwise surrender any legal rights the employee may have against the employer or any other party.

Section 7. Repeal of Section 9.08.030. Section 9.08.030 of the Haines Borough Code is hereby repealed.

Section 8. <u>Amendment of Section 12.08.160.</u> Section 12.08.160 of the Haines Borough Code is hereby amended, as follows:

12.08.160 Utility installation.

B. Underground Utilities. A utility facility may be constructed, placed, or maintained along, under, or within a borough right-of-way only in accordance with regulations adopted by the borough and if authorized by a utility right-of-way permit issued by the borough. Utility permits are valid for two years from the date of issuance. Failure to obtain a right-of way permit constitutes a minor offense, as described in HBC 1.24, punishable by a fine of \$250.00.

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Section 9. Amendment of Section 12.10.010 Section 12.10.010 of the Haines Borough Code is hereby amended, as follows:

12.10.010 Permit required - Fee.

No person may construct, reconstruct, or change a driveway located in a right-of-way within the townsite service area without having first obtained a land use right-of-way permit from the borough. All such work shall be done in accordance with plans, specifications, and standards approved by the manager. The requirement for a borough driveway right-of-way permit shall not eliminate the requirement for any other applicable permit. A person constructing a driveway accessing a state-maintained road must obtain a state DOT driveway permit. Failure to obtain a right-of way permit constitutes a minor offense, as described in HBC 1.24, punishable by a fine of \$250.00.

Section 10. Amendment of Section 12.12.040 Section 12.12.040 of the Haines Borough Code is hereby amended, as follows:

12.12.040 Installation of numbers.

Numbers at least four inches high, of a color which contrasts with the background on which they are mounted, or with a reflective surface, must be installed on each and every building as designated in the official building numbering index kept in the planning office. The developer shall place the numbers assigned by the planner on the developer's building at a location specified by the fire department for maximum visibility for police, fire, and rescue crews.

Violation of this code section constitutes a minor offense and shall be punished by a fine in the amount set forth in HBC 1.24.040, or if no fine is there established, a fine of not more than \$100.00.

Section 11. Addition of Section 12.16.040. Section 12.16.040 of the Haines Borough Code is hereby added, as follows:

12.16.040 Penalties.

Unless otherwise specifically provided, any person violating a provision of this chapter shall be guilty of a minor offense and punished by a fine in the amount set forth in HBC $\underline{1.24.040}$, or if no fine is there established, a fine of not more than \$100.00.

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Section 12. <u>Amendment of Section 15.08.060.</u> Section 15.08.060 of the Haines Borough Code is hereby amended, as follows:

STRIKETHROUGH ITEMS ARE DELETED

15.08.060 Smoking restricted.

In addition to the prohibitions set forth in Chapter <u>8.18</u> HBC, smoking in beds of hotels, motels, apartments or rooming houses, in dry-cleaning plants, or in areas where combustible materials are stored or handled is prohibited. <u>Violation of this section constitutes a minor offense</u>, as described HBC 1.24, and is punishable by a fine of \$250.00.

Section 13. Addition of Section 15.08.090. Section 15.08.090 of the Haines Borough Code is hereby added, as follows:

15.08.090 Penalties.

Unless otherwise specifically provided, any person violating a provision of this chapter shall be guilty of a minor offense and punished by a fine in the amount set forth in HBC $\underline{1.24.040}$, or if no fine is there established, a fine of not more than \$100.00.
