

A Resolution of the Haines Borough Assembly Authorizing the Borough Manager to Execute a Change Order to the Contract with Southeast Road Builders Soap Suds Alley Contract for Portage Street Drainage Improvements for an amount not to exceed \$382,305 and extend the contract by 61 days.

WHEREAS, approximately 675 feet of existing storm drain pipe along Portage Street between Fort Seward Drive and Beach road is in very poor condition and has failed in several locations; and

WHEREAS, this project would replace the existing storm drain pipe but reuse the existing storm drain structures and would include removal of asphalt, removal of concrete valley gutter, asphalt pavement patching, new concrete valley gutter (or asphalt pavement swale), and connecting to existing storm drain structures; and

WHEREAS, in June of 2023 proHNS was contracted to provide engineering services to estimate the cost and scoping of the project; and

WHEREAS, the change order is within the engineer's estimate and Southeast Road Builders has already mobilized equipment for the Soap Suds Alley project; and

WHEREAS, allowing this project to proceed via change order not only saves money but also allows the work to be completed this year; and

WHEREAS, this change order will require a 61 day extension to the existing Soap Suds Alley contract to allow for the additional work so that the larger contract will be extended through November 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly previously appropriated ARPA-LATCF funds sufficient for this project by the adoption of Ordinance 23-05-645 on June 27, 2023,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Haines Borough Assembly authorizes the Borough Manager to execute a change order with Southeast Road Builders for an amount not to exceed \$382,305 for replacement of the failed sewer pipe in Portage Street and to extend the contract until November 30, 2023 to allow for the additional work.
