RESOLUTION No. 23-09-1058

**A Resolution of the Haines Borough Assembly authorizing the allocation of FY24 Budgeted Funds to Non-profit Organizations.**

**WHEREAS**, the Haines Borough Assembly limited the funds to be granted to locally-controlled community organizations and non-profit corporations in the FY24 budget, as follows:

- \$75,000 from Fund 01: Areawide General Fund
- \$25,000 from Fund 23: Economic Development/Tourism; and

**WHEREAS**, eleven community organizations and non-profit corporations requested FY24 funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Government Affairs and Services Committee (GASC) reviewed each application to determine that the applicant was providing a service to the public; and

**WHEREAS**, the total FY24 Non-Profit Grant requests exceeded funds available for award; and

**WHEREAS**, the GASC reviewed each application using the following advertised criteria:

- Detailed Plan for Requested Funds
- Statement of Need
- Organizational Capacity
- Contributes to Economic Development
- Serves Vulnerable Haines Residents
- Broad Community Support
- Budget
- Overall Application (including requirement to be a registered Non-Profit with the IRS)

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Haines Borough Assembly that the community organizations and non-profit corporations applying for FY24 funding be allocated as follows:
