

A Resolution of the Haines Borough Assembly authorizing the Borough Manager to purchase items required for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade required by the 2020 Storm event from DXP/Alaska Pump & Supply for an amount not to exceed \$35,572.

WHEREAS, In December 2020 the Haines Borough experienced a major winter weather event that resulted in flooding, debris flows, and landslides throughout the borough; and

WHEREAS, the Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) sustained damage including damage to two pumps which need to be replaced; and

WHEREAS, these pumps repeatedly have been unable to keep up with flows during heavy rain events; and

WHEREAS, the pumps were immediately ordered, however, due to supply chain problems, the arrival of which have been significantly postponed; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has elected to purchase the pumps directly from the manufacturer to save costs and ensure the pumps match our current system; and

WHEREAS, whereas DXP/Alaska Pump & Supply quote is attached; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has an active grant DR 4585 AK, with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to reimburse the costs for repairs to Borough infrastructure and roads affected by the storm and this project is listed as PW00026; and

WHEREAS, FEMA has approved sole sourcing these items; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Haines Borough Assembly authorizes the Borough Manager purchase from DXP/Alaska Pump & Supply for an amount not to exceed \$35,572 for the project entitled Haines Wastewater Treatment Plant.
