WHEREAS, the United States of America celebrates its hard-fought independence from England annually on July 4th; and

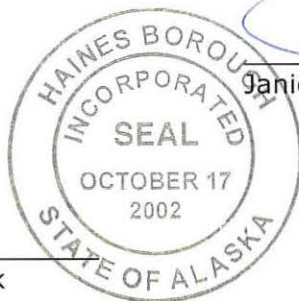
WHEREAS, July Fourth is a designated national holiday; and
