

NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES ON FEES AND OWNERSHIP CHANGE  
IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE MARIJUANA CONTROL BOARD

BRIEF DESCRIPTION

The Marijuana Control Board proposes to change regulations in Title 3, Chapter 306 of the Alaska Administrative Code dealing with ownership change and fees for ownership change.

The Marijuana Control Board proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 3, Chapter 306 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with ownership change and fees for ownership change including the following:

3 AAC 306.100(c) is amended to remove ‘ownership’ as a change requiring a fee for each license changed.

3 AAC 306.100 is amended to add a new subsection (i) to make the fee for an ownership change \$250 for a licensee owning one license and \$500 for a licensee owning two or more licenses.

Comments may also be submitted through the Alaska Online Public Notice System, by accessing this notice on the system and using the comment link. **The comments must be received not later than 4:30 pm on October 20, 2023.**

You may submit written questions relevant to the proposed action to Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office by email to [amco.regs@alaska.gov](mailto:amco.regs@alaska.gov) or by mail to 550 W. 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Suite 1600, Anchorage, Alaska, 99501. The questions must be received at least 10 days before the end of the public comment period. The Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office will aggregate its response to substantially similar questions and make the questions and responses available on the Alaska Online Public Notice System and <https://www.commerce.alaska.gov/web/amco/>

After the public comment period ends, the Marijuana Control Board will either adopt the proposed regulations or other provisions dealing with the same subject, without further notice, or decide to take no action. The language of the final regulation may be different from that of the proposed regulation. You should comment during the time allowed if your interests could be affected.
