ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD UNDER TITLE 3 OF ALASKA
ADMINISTRATIVE CODE

BRIEF DESCRIPTION

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board proposes to adopt a new chapter (305) under Title 3 of the Alaska Administrative Code. The Article affected by this notice is Article 3. A board discussion will be taking place during the board's May meeting on May 31, 2023, regarding the development of these regulations, written comments received, and hear oral comments.

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board proposes to adopt a new chapter (305) under Title 3 of the Alaska Administrative Code. The Article affected by this notice is Article 3 dealing with Retail Licenses, Endorsements and Permits:

3 AAC 305.396 is added as a new section in Article 3 and addresses common carrier approvals.

The board will be discussing these drafts and the development of these regulations, consider received written public input, and receive oral input on these drafts on the second day of its May meeting on May 31, 2023.
