- Surface of the parking lot, they make "Planting Blocks" that can be inserted into the surface paving of the parking lot
- Underground Electricity
- A park inside of the parking lot, using the evergreens that would be cut down for the project.
- Trees for shade inside of parking lot

- Trees and walkways around the perimeter of the parking lot
- Using natural trees and vegetation
- Tie in with Tlinget Park
- Save the Evergreen just off of the Memorial to incorporate into the walking trail.
- Making it very natural
- Stairs down to trail
- Picket fence around Look out Park to separate the general public from wandering into the parking lot and into harms way.
