PUBLIC NOTICE

PLAN TO VOTE!

Any person may vote in any Haines Borough election who:

- A. Is a citizen of the United States;
- B. Is 18 years or older;
- C. Has been a resident of the borough for at least 30 days just before the election;
- D. Has registered to vote in Alaska at least 30 days before the election and is not registered to vote in another jurisdiction; and
- E. Is not disqualified under Article V of the State Constitution.

If you are going to be out of town on Borough Election Day in October, you may either:

- Apply for an absentee-by-mail ballot anytime until September 24; OR
- Apply for an absentee-by-email/fax ballot anytime until October 4; OR
- <u>Vote early</u> (absentee-in-person) between September 20 and October 4 at the Borough Administration Building between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. weekdays.

BE SURE YOU ARE PROPERLY REGISTERED!

If you are not currently registered, if you have moved into or out of the borough since the last election, or if you have not voted within the last two years in a regular election, you may find that you are not properly registered or that your name has been purged from the state voter list. The deadline to register to vote is September 5, 2021 to be eligible to vote in the October 5, 2021 Haines Borough election. You may register at the Borough Administration Building weekdays from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. or with a registrar in your area. If you suspect that your registration needs to be updated (address change, etc.), please check with the Division of Elections now at https://voterregistration.alaska.gov.
