INTERIM CHIEF OF POLICE



The Haines Borough is accepting applications for an Interim Chief of Police. This temporary position reports to and is under the direct supervision of the Borough Manager. The Chief of Police is the commanding officer of the police force and supervises the activities of the Police Department and a 24/7 emergency dispatch center to protect life and property and preserve the peace through enforcement of applicable federal, state, and local laws within the boundaries of the townsite service area. Responsibilities also include managing the operation of a community jail facility and managing and monitoring animal control (currently contracted). Additionally, the interim chief will share in patrol shifts as is typical for the regular chief. The duration of this position is expected to last up to six months until a full-time, regular Chief of Police is hired.

Qualification Requirements: BA Degree in Public Safety and a minimum of 2 years of experience serving as a police chief. Correctional or jail management experience preferred. Other combinations of education and experience may be considered.

Wage and Benefits: Compensation is negotiable and dependent upon qualifications and experience. This is a non-union position and does not include benefits.
