

# Haines Borough Planning Commission Meeting February 9, 2017 MINUTES

- 1. <u>CALL TO ORDER/PLEDGE TO THE FLAG</u> Chairman **Goldberg** called the meeting to order at 6:29 p.m. in Assembly Chambers and led the pledge to the flag.
- ROLL CALL Present: Chairman Rob Goldberg; Vice Chairman Lee Heinmiller; Commissioners Brenda Josephson, Larry Geise, Jeremy Stephens, Rob Miller, and Don Turner III.

### 3. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

<u>Motion</u>: **Turner** moved to approve the agenda; **Josephson** seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

4. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES</u> – December 8, 2016 Minutes.

<u>Motion</u>: Heinmiller moved to approve the December 8, 2016 minutes; **Turner III** seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

5. <u>PUBLIC COMMENTS</u> Heather Lende introduced herself as Assembly liaison, taking on a more traditional liaison role as sitting in the audience and being available for commission questions.

### 6. CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Rob **Goldberg** welcomed Jeremy **Stephens** as newly appointed to the commission. He also notified Commission members that the Parks Ordinance was being revised administratively to include legal descriptions.

## A. Planning & Zoning Staff Report

Holly **Smith** reported six permits issued during December, mostly platting revisions. **Smith** also noted various ongoing projects.

## 8. PUBLIC HEARINGS:

A. Height Restrictions – Possible Code Amendment – A proposed amendment to HBC 18.80.030 was discussed under a third reading. Fire Chief Brian Clay noted a letter he submitted to the commission that speaks to the fire safety.

<u>Motion</u>: Rob <u>Miller</u> made a motion to recommend HBC 18.80.030 be revised to set a height limit of 30 feet for General Use and Mud Bay Rural Residential zones and decrease the height limit for Lutak Rural Residential zone from 35 feet to 30 feet, which would be heard as a public hearing

item at the next Planning Commission meeting. Don **Turner III** seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

B. Conditional Use Permit – Highland Estates, Inc. Commissioners Stephens and Josephson recused themselves from deliberation citing conflict of interest.

<u>Motion</u>: Turner III made a motion to approve the permit with conditions as amended by the commission and **Miller** seconded. The motion carried 5-0.
