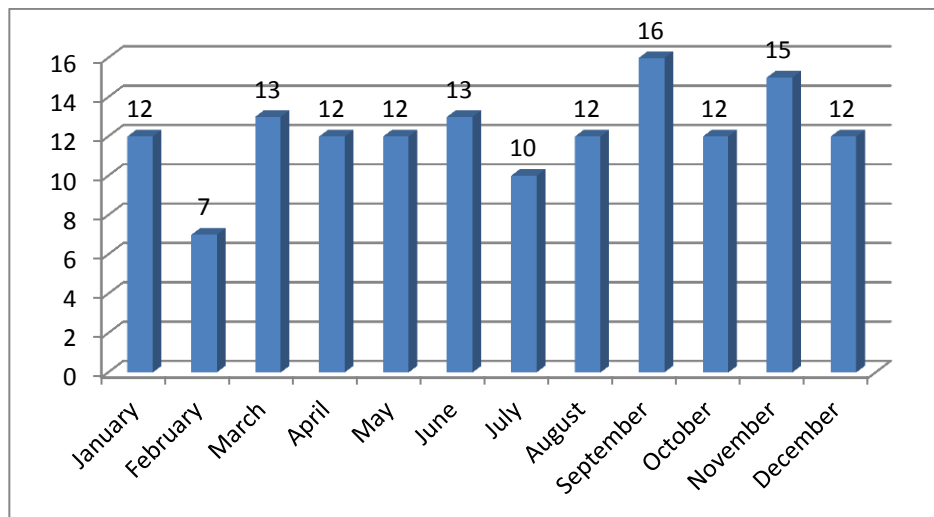

In 2017 the Haines Borough Police Department investigated 161 cases.

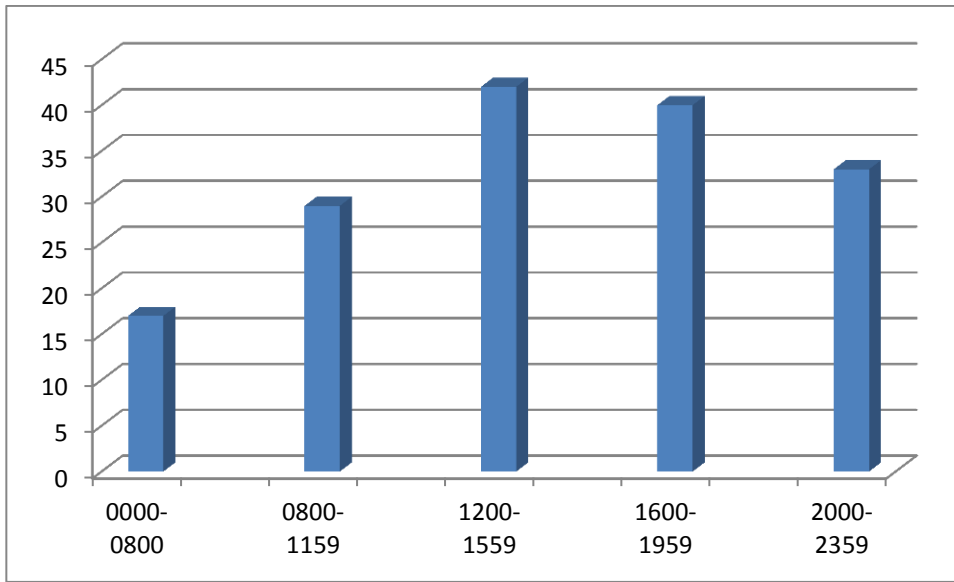
Of these 161 cases 27.95% were non-criminal while the remaining 72.05% were criminal investigations.

Cases Forwarded to the District Attorney’s Office:

HBPD forwarded 47 cases to the District Attorney’s Office for a total of 66 reported charges. Of the 66 charges forwarded; 26 are pending and have not received a disposition. The remaining 40 cases have been issued a disposition as follows:

Assault Data:

HBPD received 21 reports of Assault. Of those reports, 19 suspects were identified and 10 were immediately taken into custody. In the 21 Assault cases, 5 defendants were found guilty, 3 cases were dismissed by prosecution and 2 are still pending. Alcohol was a factor in 47.6% of the investigated assault cases and weapons were not a factor in any of the investigations. 57.1% of the assaults reported to the victim and suspect relationship was domestic.

Burglary Data:

HBPD received 3 reports of Burglaries where the total value of reported property loss is unknown; none of the losses were recovered. No suspects were arrested in any of these burglaries as there were no leads/suspects. In 2 of the 3 reports, the suspect(s) had used forced entry. Two of the buildings were residences and the other was a business.

DUI Data:

HBPD made 14 DUI arrests in 2017. 7 resulted in guilty convictions, 3 were dismissed by prosecution, 3 are pending sentencing and 1 charge of felony DUI was dismissed but charged with Refusal to Submit.

Sexual Assault Data:

HBPD investigated 8 reported sexual assaults. Of the 8 reported sexual assaults, 5 involved a minor.

Prisoners in Custody:

In 2017 the Haines Rural Jail Facility booked 57 prisoners for a total of 187 man days served (this total does not include minors or defendants serving home confinement sentence).
