SUBJECT: **Haines Rural Jail Facility 3 year Data Report**

On behalf of the Haines Borough Police Department and in support of National Law Enforcement Appreciation Day 2019 we are happy to report the lowest numbers of prisoners held in the Haines Rural Jail facility since the agency has been keeping electronic data related to this subject. I believe this number is even more significant due to our consistent staffing levels and the effective enforcement plan adopted by the agency.

It should be understood that some years on record the agency had as few as one (1) officer working for periods of time, which makes this data all the more rewarding to present. As with any law enforcement agency our goal is to support deterrence and strive for the absolutely lowest levels possible in the below listed categories.

The 3 year at a glance data shows significantly more good news, it provides that not only individuals held in the detention facility is trending down but also those held related to criminal matters. Additionally you will see that we have seen significant improvement in reducing the days Title 47 individuals are waiting for treatment in our facility.
