

An ordinance of the Haines Borough amending the Port of Haines Terminal Tariff No. 3 to adjust fee rates and adopt a revised Harbor Fee Schedule.

WHEREAS, the Haines Borough owns and operates the Portage Cove Harbor and the Letnikof Cove Harbor; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly establishes rates, fees, and penalties for Haines Borough harbor facilities; and

WHEREAS, Haines Borough Code, section 2.12.020(B), requires fines and penalties be provided by ordinance,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED, by the Haines Borough Assembly, that the following Harbor Fee Schedule is hereby adopted by ordinance.

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is not of a general and permanent nature and shall not become a part of the Haines Borough Code.

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 4. Amendment of Rule No. 34, 300, Page 15, Port of Haines Terminal Tariff No.3. Port of Haines Terminal Tariff No.3 is amended to increase Lutak dockage rates, and shall read, as follows:

RULE NO. 34 TERMINAL TARIFFS

LOA of the vessel as published in "Lloyds Register of Shipping" will be used and when not published, the Port reserved the right to: (a) obtain the LOA from the vessel's register, or (b) measure the vessel.

305. PORT CHILKOOT DOCK DOCKAGE RATES

Port Chilkoot dockage charges are assessed upon Length-Over-All (LOA) of the vessel. LOA is defined as the linear distance, in feet, from the most forward point the stem to the aftermost part of the stern of the vessel, measured parallel to the base of the vessel.

LOA of the vessel as published in "Lloyds Register of Shipping" will be used and when not published, the Port reserves the right to: (a) obtain the LOA from the vessel's register, or (b) measure the vessel.

Note: Cruise ships docking at the Port Chilkoot Dock in Haines on a regularly scheduled basis will receive a fifty percent discount on dockage rates beginning in 2017 with a sunset clause of 3 years.

Section 6. Amendment of Rule No. 34, 306, Page 15B, Port of Haines Terminal Tariff No.3. Port of Haines Terminal Tariff No.3 is amended to increase Port Chilkoot Lightering Facility rates, and shall read, as follows:

306. PORT CHILKOOT DOCK LIGHTERING FACILITY RATES

For use of Port Chilkoot Dock lightering float dock, including lightering to transfer passengers to or from larger vessels; to pick up or discharge passengers for local marine tours; moorage of vessels; and moorage of vessels unable to moor in the small boat harbor.

1. Rates:

A. Lightering or transfer of passengers to or from a larger vessel: ~~Two-hundred fifty~~ **Five Hundred** (\$2500) dollars flat rate per 24-hour period.

B. Tie Up Rates –

Regularly scheduled staff time (currently 8-5 Mon-Sun) - \$40.00 per hour

Non-regular hours - \$80.00 per hour

C. Use of the facility by vessels with a capacity of ten passengers or more to load or unload passengers for tours or charters originating or ending in Haines (per docking):

D. Any commercial vessel using the lightering facility must pay a per-passenger fee for all arrivals and departures. A minimum fee of \$30 will be assessed for each vessel arriving or departing. Standard harbor moorage rates apply to any vessel moored for over 3 hours.

- Use of the Port Chilkoot Dock Facility including the Lightering Float on a permanent or routine basis must be approved by the Borough Assembly in the form of a special use agreement ("SUA").
- In case of an emergency or lack of moorage space in the small boat harbor when the Port Chilkoot Dock Facility must be used for transient moorage, standard transient moorage rates shall apply for no more than seventy-two consecutive hours per vessel. Such use shall not interfere with the scheduled use of the dock by other vessels. Following expiration of the seventy-two hour period, standard dockage rates shall apply.
- All other vessels shall pay standard dockage rates.

Section 7. Amendment of Rule No. 34, 307, Page 15B, Port of Haines Terminal Tariff No.3. Port of Haines Terminal Tariff No.3 is amended to delete Accommodation Ladder Use rates, and shall read, as follows:

307. ITEM 307 ACCOMMODATION LADDER USE RATES **Reserved**

 There shall be a charge of \$100 for each use by a vessel of the Port's passenger accommodation ladder.

Water may be furnished to vessels at the discretion of the Haines Borough at the following rates:

400. ITEM 400 WARFAGE AND HANDLING (C)

Except as otherwise provided, wharfage rates named below are in dollars and cents per ton (2,000 pounds) or 40 cubic feet, as freighted.

Handling charges are by special arrangement with terminal use permit holders.

Permanent Open Moorage Vessels

Long-term vessels with no permanent stall that meet the conditions outlined in HBC 16.16.105(A) shall qualify for rates equal to the regular moorage rate for their size vessel (see #14 - *Annual Moorage Rates*). If the conditions are not met, transient rates apply (see #1 - *Transient Boat Moorage Fees*).

Permanent stall renters that have a second commercial vessel and meet the conditions outlined in HBC 16.16.105(A) shall qualify for rates equal to the regular moorage rate for their size vessel (see #14 - *Annual Moorage Rates*) provided the permanent stall fee is paid. If the conditions are not met, transient rates apply (see #1 - *Transient Boat Moorage Fees*), and from April 1st through September 30th these vessels shall be charged the long-term transient moorage rate.

Commercial Vessel Per-Passenger Fee

Any commercial passenger vessel utilizing harbor facilities shall pay a per-passenger fee for all embarking and disembarking passengers. Transient harbor moorage rates apply to any vessel moored for over 3 hours.


