Surplus Lumber from the Demolition of the Port Chilkoot Dock

Notice is hereby given that the Haines Borough will receive sealed competitive bids by hand-delivery or mail for the **Surplus Lumber from the Demolition of the Port Chilkoot Dock** until **3:00pm, local time, Thursday, November 14, 2013**, at the Office of the Borough Clerk, Borough Administration Building, 103 Third Ave. S., P.O. Box 1209, Haines, Alaska 99827.

Lumber Description:

Pressure treated fir in lengths up to 20 feet	Creosote Beams in lengths up to 20 feet	Creosote pilings in various lengths (minimum bid is \$1 each)
3" by 12" (min. bid is \$.50 per foot)	6" by 12" (min. bid is \$1.00 per foot)	
6" by 12" (min. bid is \$1.00 per foot)	12" by 12" beams (min. bid is \$1.50 per foot)	
12" by 12" (min. bid is \$1.50 per foot)		

Bid Requirements:

All sealed bids shall be accompanied by the following, as required by Haines Borough Code 1) name of bidder; 2) address; 3) phone number; 4) email; 5) quantity of lumber requested; 6) bid amount offered for requested lumber; and 7) signature of the agreement not to burn. Bidding forms are available on the borough's website: www.hainesalaska.gov/rfps. No deposit is required.

Bids Received and Bid Selection:

It is expected that there will be many winning bidders. First choice of material will go to the highest bidder, followed by the next highest bidder and so on. Winning bidders will be contacted via email or phone after 3pm on Thursday, November 14th. Late bids will not be accepted.

Payment and Pick Up:

Payment in cash or check ONLY is due at time of pick up. Pick up for winning bidders will be available at the Public Safety Building on Friday, Nov. 15th from 9am-12 noon or by appointment. The Haines Borough may provide a forklift to assist in loading the material. Borough staff will not assist in moving the material by hand. It is strongly suggested that bidders bring two to three people to assist in the loading process. The Borough also suggests wearing heavy-duty gloves and eye protection. Bidders must provide their own trailer, truck, etc. Failure to pick up lumber will constitute in a forfeit of the winning bid.

Borough's Rights Reserved. The borough reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informality in a bid, and to make award to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder as it may best serve the interests of the Borough.
